Health Corner!!!!

Blood pressure is the force of blood pushing against the walls of your arteries, which carry blood from your heart to other parts of your body. Blood pressure normally rises and falls throughout the day. But if it stays high for a long time, it can damage your heart and lead to health problems. High blood pressure raises your risk for heart disease and stroke, which are leading causes of death in the United States.

High blood pressure has no warning signs or symptoms, and many people do not know they have it. The only way to know if you have it is to measure your blood pressure. Then you can take steps to control it if it is too high. High blood pressure is called the "silent killer" because it often has no warning signs or symptoms, and many people do not know they have it. Rarely, high blood pressure can cause symptoms like headaches or vomiting.

Some women have high blood pressure during pregnancy. This can put the mother and her baby at risk for problems during the pregnancy. High blood pressure can also cause problems during and after delivery.^{1,2} The good news is that high blood pressure is preventable and treatable.

High blood pressure, also called hypertension, is very common. In the United States, high blood pressure happens in 1 in every 12 to 17 pregnancies among women ages 20 to 44.

High blood pressure in pregnancy has become more common. However, with good blood pressure control, you and your baby are more likely to stay healthy.

*The most important thing to do is talk with your health care team about any blood pressure problems so you can get the right treatment and control your blood pressure—**before** you get pregnant. Getting treatment for high blood pressure is important before, during, and after pregnancy.*

Bible Study is held every Wednesday night at 7:00 pm. We are studying "Twelve Ordinary Men"!

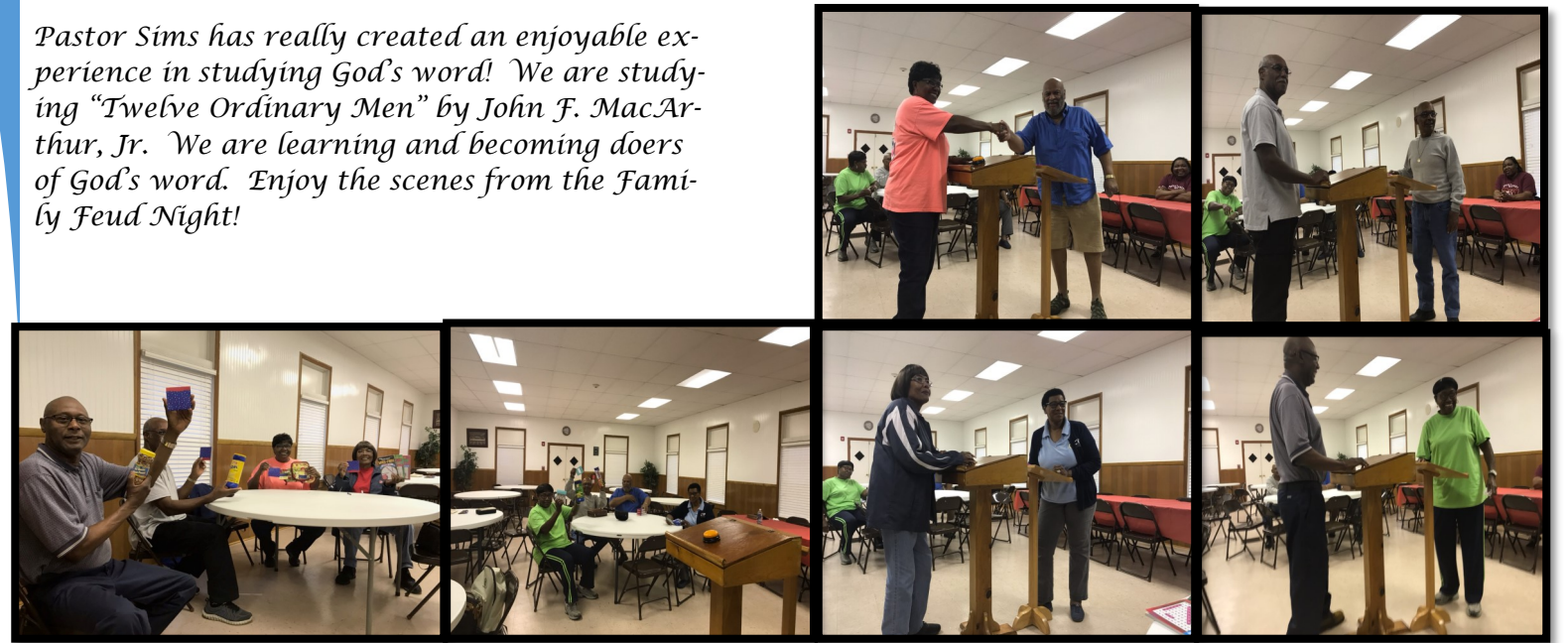
5th Sunday Worship Services!
